Heading to Camp for Your Session

Hint: Don't rely on the rubber-band type straps to hold rolled sleeping bags! Use a bag. A garbage bag works very well!

- **Pack a sack lunch and beverage to be eaten at camp.**
 - **Arrive at least 15 minutes prior to bus or boat departure to check in and load luggage.**
 - **Remember to bring camper's health form to the bus or boat ... not in suitcase!**
 - **Turn in medications with camper's name on it, in one Ziploc bag also labeled with name.**
- Bus leaves Spokane at **8:00 am Monday**.
 - Chartered buses leave from Spokane Community College Parking Lot, 3404 East Mission. The entrance to the parking lot is on Mission Ave., 1 (one) block east of Greene St. at the stoplight. Use the smaller parking lot near the Automotive Shop on the right.
 - A seat needs to be reserved for your camper on the bus. Check the enclosed statement to confirm that you reserved a seat on the bus to or from Coeur d'Alene.

Cruise Boat departing from Independence Point in Coeur d'Alene to Camp:

- The boat will leave from Independence Point Dock at **approximately 9:00 am Monday**.

Directions to Independence Point:

Take Northwest Blvd. Exit 11 from I-90, follow Northwest Blvd. south to downtown. Independence Point is east of the City Park just west of the Coeur d'Alene Resort. Parking is available in the Public Lots just east of the Coeur d'Alene Resort and at Independence Point. Please bring small bills for parking costs.

Returning from Camp - Going Home

- Upon return from camp, parents or designated adults must sign for their child at boat or bus.
- For your child's safety, your child will NOT be released except to authorized adults. Picture ID is required to pick up campers with unauthorized adults listed. Call the Registrar with questions.
- The Spokane Camp Fire office must be notified of any changes in travel arrangements or authorized adult(s). **Changes in authorized adults at bus or boat will be reviewed and approved by Camp Director or designee.**

Cruise Boat arrives at Independence Point in Coeur d'Alene from Camp:

- Boat arrives at dock at **approximately 11:30 am Friday**.

Bus arrives in Spokane at Spokane Community College:

- Bus arrives at the College at **approximately 12:30 pm Friday**.
- In the event of delays, we will be in communication with the Camp Fire Office. Road construction and traffic are generally the cause of delays, but it can be merely the time it takes to change campers from the boat to the bus and move the luggage!

Early Departure or Late Arrival

Written parental permission is required if a camper must leave camp early or arrive at camp late. Authorized adults who pick up campers should be prepared to identify themselves to camp staff.

A charge of \$5.00 per family is charged for each early departure or late arrival boat trip.
