Heading to Camp for your Session:

Don't rely on the rubber-band type straps to hold rolled sleeping bags! A garbage bag works great!

- Pack a sack lunch and beverage to be eaten at camp.
Please NO Peanut Butter or Nut Products!
- Arrive *at least* 15 minutes prior to bus or boat departure to check in and load luggage.
- Turn in medications with camper's name on it, in one Ziploc bag also labeled with name.

Bus Service departing from Spokane to the Boat in Coeur d'Alene:

- A seat needs to be reserved for your camper on the bus.
- Bus leaves Spokane at **8:00 am Friday**.
- Chartered buses leave from Spokane Community College Parking Lot, 1980 N Greene St. From the corner of Mission and Greene St., travel **NORTH** on Greene approximately 5 blocks until you reach the parking lot at Greene Street and Ermina Ave. The entrance to the parking lot is on Ermina Ave. The bus will be parked near the Clock Tower.

Cruise Boat departing from Independence Point in Coeur d'Alene to Camp:

- The boat will leave from Independence Point Dock at **9:00 am Friday**.

Directions to Independence Point:

Take Northwest Blvd. Exit 11 from I-90, follow Northwest Blvd. south to downtown. Independence Point is east of the City Park just west of the Coeur d'Alene Resort. Parking is available in the Public Lots just east of the Coeur d'Alene Resort and at Independence Point. Please bring small bills for parking costs.

Returning from Camp - Going Home:

Upon return from camp, parents or designated adults must sign for their child at boat or bus.

- For your child's safety, your child will NOT be released except to authorized adults. Picture ID is required to pick up campers with unauthorized adults listed. Call the Registrar with questions.
- The Spokane Camp Fire office must be notified of any changes in travel arrangements or authorized adult(s). **Changes in authorized adults at bus or boat will be reviewed and approved by Camp Director or designee.**

Cruise Boat arrives at Independence Point in Coeur d'Alene from Camp:

- Boat arrives at dock at **approximately 10:30 am Friday**.

Bus arrives in Spokane at Spokane Community College:

- Bus arrives at the College at **approximately 11:45 am Friday**.

Early Departure or Late Arrival:

Written parental permission is required if a camper must leave camp early or arrive at camp late. Authorized adults who pick up campers should be prepared to identify themselves to camp staff. *A charge of \$5.00 per family is charged for each early departure or late arrival boat trip.*

Delay of Bus and/or Boat:

In the event of delays, we will be in communication with the Camp Fire USA office. Road construction and traffic are generally the cause of delays, but it can be merely the time it takes to change campers from the boat to the bus and move the luggage! Depending on the location of the delay (bus and/or boat), a staff person will be stationed at the location(s) to inform parents of the situation and the estimated time for the bus/boat to arrive.
