



Camp Sweyolakan: Sailing Super Spicy 2012

The waves splash over the bow as you draw up next to your friend. You check your sails to make sure they are full. Turning on the inside, you speed past your opponent and race to the finish line! You've won the Regatta!

Program:

Spend the week learning to sail Laser ® sailboats on Mica Bay. These 1-2 man, racing class boats are perfect for learning to sail. We also have 6 AquaGlide ® boats. These are multi-function inflatable boats that can be used as a sailboat, windsurfer or kayak.

Campers must be able to complete the 10-minute swim, and will be required to wear PFD's anytime they are on the boats.

After learning about the boat, safety and basic skills, campers will practice in Echo Bay off the shores of Camp Sweyolakan. They will be expected to follow the safety procedures for boating and camping as instructed by staff members.

Once basic skills have been mastered, campers will learn about Regattas and will then participate in Camp Sweyolakan's annual Regatta. The winner's name will be placed on the trophy that is displayed in the Dining Hall.

Special Note: The Sailing Super Spicy includes an extra day and night at camp. Transportation at the completion of the program will be by Carbon Copy from the Camp Sweyolakan Landing. You must make arrangements for your camper to be picked up there at 12:30 pm on Saturday, August 4.

Clothing and Equipment:

To ensure a healthy, fun and comfortable time, we recommend you bring the following *in addition to what is listed in the Welcome Guide.*

- Water bottle/sipper
- Sunscreen
- Light colored long-sleeve shirt
- Water shoes (optional)
- Quick-dry shorts (optional)
- Waterproof camera and film (optional)
- Personal Coast Guard approved PFD

Camp will provide life jackets if campers do not bring their own, however a personal PFD can offer more comfort.
