<p><u>Essential Functions:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Must be able to tell time and follow the bugler schedule as provided by Camp Sweyolakan. ➤ Must be comfortable performing in front of others. ➤ Visual and auditory ability needed to perform the responsibilities of the position. ➤ Physical ability to perform the responsibilities of the position and to get around on rough terrain. <p><u>Minimum Qualifications:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Must be entering at least the eighth (8th) grade in the fall. ➤ Training and experience in appropriate musical instrument (bugle/coronet/trumpet/saxophone). ➤ Ability to learn and play the music properly <u>before</u> coming to camp to bugle. ➤ Ability to accept supervision and to work independently as instructed. ➤ Perform in the designated place at designated time(s), as scheduled. ➤ Enthusiasm, sense of humor, patience and self-control. 			
<p><u>RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE POSITION:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Attend bugler orientation by 5:30 pm with Staff Director or assigned staff member on first day in camp. ➤ Know the music and be familiar with schedule prior to arrival at camp. ➤ Bring own instrument and play music provided according to schedule. ➤ Discuss with Staff Director <i>any</i> programming conflicts with Bugler Schedule (overnights, cookouts, etc.) prior to the scheduled playing time. ➤ Must be able to tell time and follow the Bugler Schedule provided at camp. ➤ Bring an alarm clock and a watch. ➤ Accept added responsibilities as asked. ➤ Agree to follow directions given by Staff Director, and to abide by the responsibilities and expectations outlined above.
