Council "Fair Share"

Our Council's Fair Share is set at 75 packages. To meet our Council's goal, each youth member **must** sell their Fair Share. At the Fair Share level you begin to earn candy credit, earn more money for your club and fulfill one of the requirements for earning the Sales and Sense emblem.

Candy Fundraiser Awards:

Club rebate

Help your club earn money with each package of candy you sell! Your club will earn \$.20 per package on individual sales of 1-74 packages. On all sales over 75 packages, your club earns \$.35 per package.

Candy Credit

An individual seller may use Candy Credit toward any Inland Northwest Council program. This includes any camp and club program within our council. For instance, if you are unable to attend camp, you may use your Candy Credit to pay for a club event such as roller skating or the Adventure Overnight, or you may use your candy credit in the council and camp stores*. At the 75 package level, you will earn \$60 in Candy Credit. At the 90 package level, you will earn \$80 in candy credit. From 105 packages up to 240 packages you will then earn \$10 in candy credit for every 15 packages of candy you sell. At 255 packages, you begin earning \$15 in candy credit for every 15 packages candy, or \$1.00 for every package!

Families

We also continue to offer a Family Candy Credit account. The packages sold by members of the same family/ household will be combined to calculate candy credit. In most instances this is a benefit to the family. Any registered family member may sell to contribute to the Family Account. Family Awards include the Candy Camporee at Sweyolakan for 2 youth at 390 packages and the 1,000 Family Trophy at 1,000 packages sold.

Candy Awards Night:

All candy sellers, candy volunteers and their families will be invited to attend a special awards night following the Candy Fundraiser. This event will recognize the hard work and success of the candy sellers as well as our dedicated candy volunteers. Date, time and location will be included in the invitation.

Tips for Success:

How to sell 75 packages of candy:

- Sell to family and close friends - 15 pkgs
- Sell in your neighborhood - 15 pkgs
- Sell at stores (with permission) - 15 pkgs
- Sell at parent's office - 15 pkgs
- Sell in two other familiar neighborhoods - 15 pkgs

Best Times to Sell

- Weekdays: 5:00-6:30 pm
- Saturdays: 10:00-11:30 am

Safety Rules for Selling Candy

1. Sign and agree to safety standards in the Parent/Sell Responsibilities Agreement form. This must be turned in to your child's leader/candy chair prior to participation in the Candy Fundraiser.
2. All sellers must be supervised by an adult and must never sell alone when selling door-to-door and when selling at a store location.
3. Never enter the home of a stranger.
4. While it is good to say why you are selling candy or introduce yourself, never tell your last name.
5. Do not carry large amounts of money. Turn money in to your club's assigned candy chair on a regular basis.
6. Follow traffic safety rules at all times and sell only in familiar areas.
7. Dress appropriately for weather conditions.
